Camp Kum-Ba-Ya (KBY)**

Welcome to camp! This contains information about the camp events offered this summer at Kum-Ba-Ya, as well as offered off site. Please keep reading for important information about this summer's offerings. Where there is an "X" on the registration form, a signature is required by a camper, parent or minister.

The Christian Church In Kentucky wants every young person to have an opportunity to experience camp, so attend any camping event offered in your age group. In fact you may want attend more than one event! Come when it fits your schedule, and you will have the time of your life! Also, your friends are welcome here too.

A reminder for parents, clergy and youth sponsors that full payment must be included with the registration form. Registration forms received without all signatures and full payment will not be processed at either office. So, please let your church treasurer or minister know that you need a check to accompany your registration when it is mailed.

On behalf of all the children, youth and young adults who pass through the gates of Kum-Ba-Ya this summer I thank you and your congregation for the support and prayers.

Registration Confirmations are emailed to Parents – so print clearly.

Things to Bring: Pillow, sleeping bag or 2 sheets and a blanket, casual clothing-shorts, slacks/jeans, shoes, bathing suit, towels, wash cloths, soap, etc. Other: Bible, pencils, notebook, musical instrument, flashlight with extra batteries, stamps, money for canteen and offering. Rainwear is usually needed.

Things NOT to Bring: Laptops, video gaming systems, iPods/MP2 players, DVD players. Do not bring weapons of any kind, fireworks, alcohol or tobacco products. Camper WILL BE sent home before the end of the event if weapons, fireworks, alcohol or tobacco products are found. No candy or food as they attract mice.

Grade Completed: CYF: 9-12; Sailing CYF: 9-12 (limited to 15); Sailing Chi Rho: 6-8 (limited to 10); Chi-Rho: 6-8; Junior: 4-5; Mini: 3; Discovery Camp 101: 1-2; TREC: 9-12 (limit to 12); Sports: 6-12.

Policies: Smoking is not permitted. **No "graffiti" of any kind is permitted.** Campers are expected to stay the full time and should not leave the camp at anytime without permission of the Camp Director. Any camper driving to camp will not be allowed to leave camp early without written permission of parent or guardian. **VISITORS are NOT permitted during camp.** The gate entrance will be locked at all times to ensure that campers are safe. **All Phone** messages will be relayed through the adult staff to campers but campers will not be called to the phone. The phone will not be available for campers.

Emergencies: In case of a family emergency please contact the campsite by telephone and ask to speak to a director. Please do not show up at a camp unannounced or without the approval of a camp director. In the event that a camper needs emergency medical treatment a camp director will contact parents via the emergency contact number listed.

Medical Insurance: *Be sure to list your family (campers) medical insurance information. If a camper must go to the hospital during a week of camp we will list the family insurance as primary and camp insurance as secondary on the admission form.*

Refunds: If cancellation is necessary notify the Administrative Camp Office. All cancellations are subject to a \$15 administration fee withheld from the refund. Cancel at least 14 days prior to your event, and the entire registration fee will be refunded. Cancel 13-10 days prior, and 50% of fee will be refunded. No camp fees will be refunded for cancellations less than 10 days prior to the beginning of a camp. No camp fees will be refunded for no-shows the day of camp.

Equal Opportunity: Camp is open to all regardless of race, creed, color or national origin.

Email to Campers: Email is only available during the camping season. The director(s) will check email and print for the campers. Email will be given out no more than twice a day. *Please do not send e-cards or photos* because they are awkward to print. Campers will not be allowed access to the computer. All email goes through the director (or director's designee) to the camper. **Kum-Ba-Ya:** cckkby@wk.net

Registration

1. All registrations for any camp experience are due to the appropriate office no later than **two weeks prior** to the opening day of a camp. If a camp is filled youth will be put on a waiting list and contacted by mail.
2. The camper, the parent(s) and the minister representing your congregation must sign the registration form. If no minister is currently serving the congregation an elder representing your congregation can sign the form.
3. A check for the full payment must accompany the registration form. A registration form that is received without the appropriate signatures and payment will not be processed. *It is preferred that families pay your congregation, and have the congregation send one check for all their registration at one time.*
