### A few Camp Rules More... (all rules shared during orientation)

- Smoking is not permitted.
- ✓ No "graffiti" of any kind is permitted.
- ✓ Campers are expected to stay the full time and should not leave the camp at anytime without permission of the Camp Director.
- Any camper driving to camp will not be allowed to leave camp early without written permission of parent or guardian.
- ✓ VISITORS are NOT permitted during camp. The gate entrance will be locked at all times to ensure camper safety.
- ✓ Emergencies: In case of a family emergency please contact the campsite by telephone and ask to speak to a director. In the event that a camper needs emergency medical treatment a camp director will contact parents via the emergency contact number listed.
- ✓ Medications, please send an updated list of all medications, include dosage and frequency information. Send all medications in original containers. Emergency Medications are to be brought to camp. These include EpiPen, insulin, etc. If a camper arrives without these they will be sent home.
- ✓ Please do not show up at a camp unannounced or without the approval of a camp director. The gate at the camp will remain locked during camp events.

- ✓ Medical Insurance: Be sure to list your medical insurance info. If a camper is injured and must go to the hospital during camp we will list the family insurance as primary and camp insurance as secondary on the forms.
- ✓ Refunds: If cancellation is necessary notify the Camp Business Office, All cancellations are subject to a \$15 administration fee withheld from the refund. Cancel at least 14 days prior to event, and the entire registration fee will be refunded. Cancel 13-10 days prior, 50% of fee will be refunded. No camp fees will be refunded for cancellations less than 10 days prior to the beginning of a camp. No camp fees will be refunded for noshows.
- ✓ All Phone messages will be relayed through the adult staff to campers but campers will not be called to the phone. The phone will not be available for campers.
- ✓ Liability: The Christian Church In Kentucky is not responsible for personal items that are lost, stolen or broken at camp.
- ✓ Equal Opportunity: KBY is open to all regardless of race, creed, color or national origin.

Registration confirmations are emailed to parents – <u>so print</u> <u>clearly</u> when you fill out the registration forms.
