FROM THE VIRTUAL DESK

Do you have an elevator pitch? You know, a short statement about the why of your work? In this ministry I'm often asked to quickly tell what the West Area is, does, and is currently doing. As I respond I often focus on the three guiding words for the regional work of the Christian Church In Kentucky: care, connect, and equip.

I tell them that in the West Area we CARE for our 88 clergy and their families. We care for the 42 churches of Districts 1, 2, and 3. We care for children, youth, young adults, and adults of our churches through our camping ministries and West Area Youth Council programing (see page 1).

I say that we CONNECT churches with churches, clergy with clergy, clergy with churches, and churches with clergy. We connect those in the West Area to opportunities beyond our three districts and invite them to experience and know the wider church beyond our doorsteps (see page 3 for examples).

And I tell how we EQUIP leaders for God's service through training events, like the upcoming West Area Workshops (see page 5) or AR/PR (held in January), and leadership opportunities, like WAYC and camp, and through our Committee on Ministry.

I admit that it's challenging, but it's meaningful, inspiring work, because almost every day we get to witness something new God is doing in the West Area. What's your testimony of what God is doing among us?




DECREASE IN PARTICIPATING MEMBERS ACROSS THE WEST AREA FROM 2018 TO 2020



ANNOUNCING A CALLED MEETING OF THE WEST AREA ON MARCH 7

Rev. Jeff Mandrell, West Area board chair, has announced a Called Meeting of the West Area membership on March 7 at First Christian Church, 2601 S. Walnut Street, Hopkinsville to be held at the completion of the closing worship of the West Area Workshops event (about 3:30 p.m.). The single item of business for this meeting is to consider changes to the Constitution & By-laws approved by the West Area Board on February 16. Changes to the Constitution and By-laws require a 2/3 vote of approval from those in attendance."
