KUM-BA-YA SUMMER CAMP UPDATE

After receiving input from our camp directors, the Marshall County Health Deptartment, and from colleagues in the Association of Disciples Outdoor Ministries, the Camp Kum-Ba-Ya Advisory Team has made the difficult decision to not hold in-person camps or retreats at KBY through August 2020. Our hearts are broken to have to make this decision, but we know that it is the best one for the safety of our staff, our volunteers, our campers and their families. We look forward to the day when we can be back together again to watch a sunset on the dock, sing songs around the campfire, play 4-square, worship at the lakeside vespers, and be reunited with our camp friends and counselors. The advisory team will continue to monitor reports from the governor, the Marshall County Health Department, and the CDC to be ready to plan safe gatherings at KBY as soon as it is responsible to do so.

No doubt, Camp Kum-Ba-Ya is a sacred place where we so easily bond with one another to create beloved community. Our time together makes it so much easier to feel God's presence and share God's love. At every closing circle on the last day of camp we talk about how important it is to take what we've experienced and created together and carry it with us back into our lives at home. And this year, our mission will be to do the

work of community building and connecting with God from our own homes.

Instead of traditional in-person camps, Camp Kum-Ba-Ya directors and staff are at work right now preparing an entirely new program of virtual gatherings. We know that this will not replace the inperson camp experience at Camp KBY, but we are excited to see the new things God will do through technology. What ministry is possible here that wasn't possible before? How might virtual and at-home camp community be a gift to each of us, to give us the rhythm and community to help us get through these difficult days? So, watch KBY's social media, website, and your email for details about our new off-site opportunities, and please share them across and beyond your congregations as they are rolled out. This summer we have an unprecedented opportunity to share the gospel to a new group of virtual campers. Our camp theme this year is "This is Our Prayer," so let's be in prayer for our leaders and for one another as we discern where God is leading us in this new way of being community. WEST AREA RECEIVES SBA LOAN

PROVIDES TWO AND A HALF MONTHS PAYROLL AT CAMP KBY AND WEST AREA

In early April, West Area Treasurer Charlie Ramsey and Office Manager Glori Cope sprung into action to quickly secure a Payroll Protection Program loan from the Small Business Administration. This loan will provide two and a half months of payroll for all West Area and camp employees, including our seasonal staff. If used according to the terms, the loan may be 100% forgiven. This is the first step in doing all that we can to ensure that our ministries are adequately funded during these challenging times. After April's financial reports are reconciled, and we get a full picture of the financial health of our ministries, the treasurer plans to give a report to update the West Area on our financial position and outlook. We are gratful to those who continue to support Camp Kum-Ba-Ya and the West Area.
