

KBY RENOVATIONS UPDATE



Renovation work on the Billy Williams Lodge bathrooms, siding, and doors remains incomplete. The contract with the construction company involved has now been terminated, and The Christian Church In Kentucky, as the owner of record of the camp property, is considering options to protect our interest in the camp and its ministry and to recoup any losses stemming from the incomplete work.

The Camp Kum-Ba-Ya Advisory Team reported on January 17 to the West Area Board that plumbing projects, roof repairs, and installation of new heating and air conditioning systems have been completed successfully. In the coming weeks the Advisory Team will work with a new contractor to complete the unfinished work on the Lodge and complete preparations for the 2021 camping season.

TREASURER'S REPORT

DECEMBER AND END OF THE YEAR HIGHLIGHTS

West Area:

Receipts for the year ended December 31, 2020, came in greater than budget. Actual operating income was \$89,766 versus budgeted income of \$81,954. This was due to some congregations giving more than we anticipated. Operating expenses for the year came in less than budget by \$12,814. This was due mainly to mileage expense and office expense being less than anticipated. The combined amounts resulted in our operating cash increasing by \$18,125, which left us with an operating cash balance of \$56,011. As of December 31st our PPP loan has not been forgiven, but we are assured by bank officials it will be soon. We had a decrease in restricted fund balance, due mainly to necessary caretaker-residence repairs.

Camp Kum-Ba-Ya:

We started the year with an operational cash balance of \$30,603 and ended the year with an operational balance of \$8,218. Due to the COVID-19 we were unable to hold camp in 2020, resulting in lost estimated camp revenue of almost \$35,000. Budgeted expenses of \$71,822 actually came in less at \$49,289. The savings were mostly food, event supplies, liability insurance, and utilities.
