TREASURER'S REPORT

JANUARY HIGHLIGHTS

West Area:

The great news for January was the forgiveness of our federal Payroll Protection Program (PPP) loan in the amount of \$13,600. We included that amount in income in January. We also had a generous individual gift of \$4,000 and regular congregation gifts of \$4,857, the combined three amounts totaled \$22,457. We had expenses totaling \$5,768. The difference of \$16,689 added to our beginning balance of \$56,011 left us with a month end balance of \$72,700. With the pandemic still hanging around, we had virtually no West Area minister field expense, no administrative expense and very little office expense. We expect this to change in the near future, however.

Camp Kum-Ba-Ya:

Again, during January we had PPP loan forgiveness in the amount of \$10,892 and expenses of \$2,163. We started the month with \$8,218 and ended with a balance of \$17,047. We normally try to start the year with around \$60,000 to meet the needs of our campers. With many fixed expenses remaining during 2020 and no camper income to offset it, we ended with a pretty big deficit for 2020. Plans are underway to help alleviate the situation in the near future. We still have available \$14,263 in restricted funds, which are basically available for KBY upgrades and improvements.
