## TREASURER'S REPORT

### MARCH HIGHLIGHTS

#### West Area:

The West Area had income in excess of expenses by \$6,798 in March. This was due mainly to receipt of \$3,750 from Disciples Mission Fund support. Also there was no office manager expense and very little other expense.

The operational account balance increased to \$77,235 while the restricted account remained unchanged at \$2,202.

#### Camp Kum Ba Ya:

KBY had operational income in excess of expenses in the amount of \$16,475 due mainly to a receipt of \$16,098 from the annual CCK Camp Endowment Fund draw. Congregational gifts were \$3,168. The largest expense was utilities in the amount of \$2,311.

#### **Endowment Fund:**

The Field & Main account value increased in the first quarter by \$5,205 to a new balance of \$252,087. We have yet to take a budgeted draw of \$11,844 for 2021.
