A CULTURE OF CALL

FROM THE VIRTUAL DESK

I am so thankful that, when I was a teenager, on multiple occasions adults came to me and told me that they saw I had been given gifts for ministry. I was feeling the call myself, but there were times that I doubted. So when one of these adults would boldly speak words of encouragement to me, it gave me the strength and hope to keep exploring the call to ministry.

Whom do you know--of any age-- that God might be calling into the ministry? Whom might you encourage to keep discerning and exploring?

l Thessalonians 5:ll tells us that we are "to encourage one another and build up each other..." (NRSV). When we see spiritual gifts in others, we should tell them so. When we encounter someone with the gift of teaching, or pastoring, or leading, we have the opportunity to let them know that we appreciate those gifts, and we can see how God might use them in our world. We are all called to ministries, and God can use each of us to inspire those calls in one another.

FALL WORK DAY

Looking for a meaningful day of mission work? Join us 8:00 a.m. Central on Saturday, October 16 for our Fall Work Day at Camp Kum-Ba-Ya (4943 Barge Island Rd., Benton). Camp Caretaker, Denny Flaherty, has outlined several projects for us to tackle. Please bring your work gloves, a mask, tools, equipment, and your friends. A yummy lunch will be served. And, if you can't make Work Day, but want to schedule another time to come down, email Denny (dennyflaherty@gmail.com). Denny's fall project checklist includes:

- 1. Rebuild small vespers seating by dining hall. Power wash stage. Stain seating and stage.
- 2. Clear out debris at old men's restroom and install new door and shelving.
- 3. Move all materials from old women's shower house to old men's shower house. Clean and paint inside.
- 4. Move red rock pile from caretaker's house. Skid Steer will be needed.
- 5. Tear down old concrete pillars and asphalt at front gate and dispose. Direction will be given on work day.
- 6. Install mulch barrier and spread mulch at newer shower houses.
- 7. Build new firewood stand at the pavilion.
- 8. Spread barrier and rock underneath deck at men's shower house.
- 9. Repair all retaining walls throughout camp.
- 10. Winterize camp. Put away benches, kayaks and canoes.
- 11. Move concrete steps to caretaker's house.
- 12. Perform screen, electric, and light repairs at cabins.
- 13. Replenish firewood. Fell, buck and split firewood. Power splitter and chain saws will be needed.
- 14. Move material from tractor shed.
- 15. Clean up trails and camp property of stick and rocks.
