

TREASURER'S REPORT

OCTOBER HIGHLIGHTS

West Area: We had substantial Congregational support in October totaling \$10,591, putting us at a year-to-date total of \$60,277 or 94% of our annual budget. We had total expenses of \$4,315, giving us a positive cash flow for the month of \$6.275. We ended the month with a cash balance of \$86.789.

Camp Kum-Ba-Ya: So far this year we have had receipts of \$74,557 with expenses of \$62,189, giving us a positive cash flow of \$14,368. The ending cash balance was \$22,586.

The restricted fund balance was \$20,407, which will be used mainly on Camp upgrades.


