### **FEELING THE LOVE**

#### FROM THE VIRTUAL DESK

After the devastating tornadoes on December 10 and 11, and again on January 1, Rev. Caroline Hamilton-Arnold from Week of Compassion immediately began working with the Christian Church in Kentucky-West Area to identify members in churches that were impacted. Since then, over \$21,000 in Household Solidarity Grants have been given out to 52 Disciples households across the West Area. First Christian Mayfield, whose building was deemed a total loss, also received a Congregational Solidarity Grant to help them in this time. And, so far, West Area churches have received over \$7.700 (and counting) in Community Solidarity Grants and volunteer support as they strive to help their neighbors in need through innovative ministries.

Behind the scenes, Week of Compassion connects with KY- VOAD (Voluntary Organizations Active in Disasters) and other recovery efforts to provide the West Area on-the-ground information and opportunities for churches to engage in appropriate responses in each community, whether it be connecting with low-income housing initiatives, feeding ministries, FEMA process training, mental-health services, or other long-term recovery ministries.

Week of Compassion continues to stand at the center of all of these efforts and assist us with the challenging work of long-term recovery. I hope ministers and lay leaders from your church will join in this important conversation with Caroline on March 13.



### TREASURER'S REPORT

#### FEBRUARY HIGHLIGHTS

#### West Area:

We had total receipts of \$4,329. We had total expenses of \$4,806, giving us a negative cash flow of \$476. This is common for the first of the year. We ended the month with a total cash balance of \$110,563.

#### Camp Kum-Ba-Ya:

The total regular receipts for January were \$2,500 with regular expenses of \$2,925 giving us a negative cash flow of \$425. We ended the month with an operational cash balance of \$22,380. We had a restricted cash balance of \$22,977 which will be used mainly on Camp upgrades. During the month we received a \$5,000 individual contribution and we paid \$2,500 for repairs.
