The big night of music, magicians, a quilt raffle, food-venders, and speakers was called "Jeffersontown Cares," and it gathered together city leaders, church leaders, and caring Disciples, and other local citizens to excee their goal and raise \$10,505. Diana even came to the West Area to learn more about the impacts of the storms and hand-delivered the check to us in Madisonville.

The West Area will serve as custodian of these funds, and Board Chair Rev. Jeff Mandrell is forming a task group for their distribution in the coming months of long-term recovery.
