FROM THE VIRTUAL DESK

This week two ministry colleagues have shared with me articles that explore the pervasive burnout that many pastors and chaplains report experiencing.

Even as clergy have wrestled with the best ways to prevent COVID outbreaks within the congregation, ministers have lived with anxieties over their own health and the health of their families. When members were dying alone in care facilities under quarentine, their heart-broken chaplains and pastors did what they could to be a pastoral presence, even when that presence had to be from the other side of a window. The pandemic required pastors to acquire new skills for using technology to reach us in lockdown, and this additional work placed upon pastors has not let up even as most worshipers return to the sanctuary. Hybrid is our new way of being church, and ministers are feeling behind the digital eight ball as all eyes are on them to "fix it" when the tech equipment is inadequate



From the pulpit the pastors look out across the pews and see the empty seats once occupied by beloved members who have died because there have been so many funerals. Our ministers are grieving them, too. And all of this is set within a divisive political climate in our country that is challenging Christian unity within our church families, and pastors are feeling attacked from all sides.

Our West Area clergy need time to be together--time to rest and play, time to worship and time to share what they have been experiencing. On October 4, we will be hosting a retreat just for our ministers (chaplains or pastors, active or retired) to be together and be reminded that we are not alone. Dee and I can't wait to be there together with you all in person. Let's break in that new ping-pong table!
