### TREASURER'S REPORT

Financial Information for September 2022:

West Area: We had total receipts of \$4,115. We had total expenses of \$8,710, giving us a negative cash flow of \$4,595. For the nine months ended September 30 we have a total negative cash flow of \$6,050. We ended the month with an operating cash balance of \$100,087. We have a restricted cash balance of \$15,826 which consists of \$13,205 in tornado relief contributions.

Camp Kum-Ba-Ya: The total year to date receipts for the nine months ended September 30 were \$48,414 with total expenses of \$64,489 giving us a negative cash flow of \$16,075. We ended the period with an operational cash balance of \$6,731. We had a restricted cash balance of \$24,575 which will be used mainly on Camp upgrades.
