FURNITURE FUNDRAISER IN JANUARY

In January, we'll be launching a fundraiser to turn our campground into a year-round ministry. Join in our "Furnishings Fundraiser" to raise funds to purchase new beds, mattresses, storage, and other furnishings for our new camper cabins and retreat cabins at Camp Kum-Ba-Ya.

At Camp Kum-Ba-Ya, we are committed to aiding the spiritual growth of children, youth, and adults through outdoor and camping ministry. A gift from the Issac Sterett Adventure Foundation (ISAF) provides a giant leap forward in this ministry. We have received eight new buildings. Six are being converted into duplex cabins, able to house 11 campers on each side. Plus, ISAF plans to renovate two additional retreat cabins with living areas, kitchenettes, restrooms, and a separated bedroom. All eight buildings are heated and cooled.

The KBY Furnishing Task Group will be seeking a goal of \$90,000 for our Furnishings Fundraiser to outfit the new facilities. Purchasing these items will help us best utilize this new gift, both for our campers next summer and for outside groups looking to reserve facilities. TREASURER'S REPORT

Financial information for October 2022:

West Area:

For the month, we had total receipts of \$8,604. We had total expenses of \$6,126, giving us a positive cash flow of \$2,478. For the ten months ended October 31 we had a total negative cash flow of \$3,572. We ended the month with an operating cash balance of \$102,566. We have a restricted cash balance of \$15,826 which consists of \$13,205 in tornado relief contributions. By year end we expect to receive \$3,750 for DMF support and \$1,100 for Smallwood Interest. We also plan to receive a scheduled draw from our Endowment Funds totaling \$11,718.

Camp Kum-Ba-Ya:

The total year to date receipts for the nine months ended October 31 were \$57,496 with total expenses of \$67,242 giving us a negative cash flow of \$9,746. We ended the period with an operational cash balance of \$13,059. We had a restricted cash balance of \$17,844 which will be used mainly on Camp upgrades. By year end we expect to receive approximately \$17,000 as a CCK endowment.
