THE LIGHT STILL SHINES



One year has now passed since the devastating tornadoes of December 10-11, 2021. In this year, I have been so inspired by the ways that our churches have supported one another and reached out to their neighbors to represent hope and show the love of Christ.

Seven of our churches sought and received Week of Compassion community solidarity grants to creatively serve their neighbors, and many others directed their church's talent and treasure to respond to needs in their communities. Or partnered with other churches in the West Area to help neighboring communities begin to recover from the overwhelming devastation.

Three of our churches continue to host long-term recovery teams to rebuild our communities:

• First Christian Madisonville is hosting a longterm recovery site operated by the Fuller Center. https://fullercenter.org/disasterrebuilders/

- First Christian Paducah will be partnering with two organizations in 2023 to assist with community recovery in Mayfield:
 - Join an International Orthodox Christian Charities home build team as a group or on your own. Come for a week (Sunday - Saturday), or choose as many days as work for you.



• First Christian in Paducah will also be partnering with Week of Compassion and Be The Neighbor this summer to host youth groups for disaster recovery and education. Mayfield is intentionally rebuilding in ways that make homeownership and safe affordable housing more available. You will work on construction rebuilding projects, build relationships with neighbors and learn about housing justice and best
