FURNISHINGS FUNDRAISER

Our West Area Finance and Fundraising Committee is raising funds to purchase new beds, mattresses, and other needed furnishings for our camper cabins and our two new retreat cabins. Our hope and vision is to be a place that draws ministers, families, churches, and other groups to seek meaningful and fun retreat time in God's beautiful creation. With new furniture for our climate-controlled cabins, our campers and guests will have a more enjoyable stay in the heat of summer and the cold of winter, providing a comfortable and inviting space for our campers. We believe that all campers should have the best possible experience, and this furniture for our new cabins is an essential part of that.

So, how do we get to our \$90,000 goal? Well, we will need some large gifts, like the one we just received from The Legacy Fund of First Christian

Church Owensboro and Century Christian Church. We are so honored to receive this grant and to represent their legacies.

And, we will need Camp Alumni far and wide to give back to this special place.

We'll also need several of our West Area churches to raise funds for this effort. One pastor suggested that an envelope fundraiser (where you number envelopes 1-100 and invite donors to fill it with a gift in the amount on the envelope) would raise \$5,050. Another thought that having a "Camp MEATing" and selling BBO meat would be a great way for a church to get their community involved. Some churches have their children collect "noisy offerings" or "change for change" in coffee cans during worship for causes they believe in. Several counties in Kentucky offer trash-for-cash to church groups to clean roadways and raise funds. Car washes, bake sales, spaghetti suppers, and rummage sales are all fun ways to raise money for camp. What ideas might your church plan to raise funds for furniture at Camp Kum-Ba-Ya?

And, we'll need YOU, because you know that camp changes lives and inspires new generations of leaders for our churches. Please join me in supporting the work of the Finance Committee, the KBY Advisory Team, and all those who make camp such a spiritually enriching experience.

## TREASURER'S REPORT

#### West Area:

The total receipts for the year ended December 31, 2022, were \$97,437 with total expenses of \$86,055 giving us a positive cash flow of \$11,382. We ended the year with an operational cash balance of \$117,520. We have a restricted cash balance of \$19,886, which includes \$13,205 in tornado relief contributions.

#### Camp Kum-Ba-Ya:

The total receipts for the year ended December 31, 2022, were \$79,940 with total expenses of \$73,011 giving us a positive cash flow of \$6,929. We ended the year with an operational cash balance of \$29,735. We had a restricted cash balance of \$28,006, which will be used mainly on camp upgrades. Operational highlights include camper fees \$7,424 in excess of budget, congregational gifts \$8,957 in excess of budget and CCK Endowment \$1,165 in excess of budget. In the expense area we had Repairs Maintenance and Supplies with the total exceeding budget by \$5,987, which was due mainly to the new facilities. In the Restricted Funds we had a nice jump on our \$90,000 Fundraising Goal to equip the new facilities with a \$10,000 legacy gift and individual contributions of \$2,222.
