
When Jim and his sisters got to work on Mr. Midkiff's obituary, they wanted to give people an option to contribute to some difference-making organization.

TREASURER'S REPORT

For the Month Ended January 31, 2023:

West Area: The total receipts for the month ended January 31, 2023 were \$3,799 with total expenses of \$8,719 giving us a negative cash flow of \$4,920. We ended the month with an operational cash balance of \$107,708. We have a restricted cash balance of \$19,886 which consists of \$13,205 in tornado relief contributions.

Camp Kum-Ba-Ya: The total receipts for the month ended January 31, 2023 were \$1,715 with total expenses of \$3,255 giving us a negative cash flow of \$1,808. We ended the month with an operational cash balance of \$27,933. We had a restricted cash balance of \$28,296 which will be used mainly on camp upgrades and furniture purchases.
