## TREASURER'S REPORT

#### West Area:

The total receipts for the month ended February 28, 2023 were \$10,857, with total expenses of \$9,798 giving us a positive cash flow of \$1,059. We ended the month with an operational cash balance of \$107,767. We have a restricted cash balance of \$18,877, which consists of \$13,205 in tornado relief contributions.

#### Camp Kum-Ba-Ya:

The total receipts for the month ended February 28, 2023 were \$123, with total expenses of \$5,423, giving us a negative cash flow of \$5,300. We ended the month with an operational cash balance of \$22,632. We had a restricted cash balance of \$34,911, which will be used mainly on camp upgrades and furniture purchases. The restricted cash balance includes \$19,127 from our current fundraising efforts to furnish the new cabins.
