


APPLY BY AUGUST 1 TO JOIN WAYC

The application deadline is **August 1**. An informational flyer and application may be found on the WAYC webpage. Help us spread the word about this unique opportunity.



STANDING FORMS DUE AUGUST 18



As part of its responsibilities, the region in the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) certifies the standing of ministers.

The regional office won't be mailing out standing forms to all ministers, as we have done in the past. We will mail standing forms to any ministers who have indicated a preference for receiving physical mail and to ministers that don't have an e-mail address listed in our database. The standing renewal process will open on July 10 and we would like to have it completed by August 18, so the Committee on the Ministry can approve standing for all of our ministers for the 2024 calendar year at their September Annual Meeting.

It is our hope that most ministers will complete their standing form on-line by visiting the Region's website (www.ccinky.net) and following the menus to Resources – Ministers – Ministerial Standing Form. TREASURER'S REPORT

Financial Information for the month ended June 30, 2023:

West Area:

The total receipts for the month ended June 30, 2023 were \$8,507 with total expenses of \$11,814 giving us a negative cash flow of \$3,307. We ended the month with an operational cash balance of \$98,041.

We have a restricted cash balance of \$11,489 which consists mainly of \$6,455 in tornado relief contributions and \$4,540 in youth activities restricted monies.

Camp Kum-Ba-Ya:

The total operational receipts for the month ended June 30, 2023 were \$9,026 with total expenses of \$17,869 giving us a negative cash flow of \$8,843. We ended the month with an operational cash balance of \$26,566. There were several churches that had outstanding camper fees that were paid in July. We also had a restricted cash balance of \$103,389 which will be used mainly on Camp upgrades and furniture purchases. The large amount was due to a very successful fundraising drive.
