

FROM THE TREASURER

I would like to follow up from my chat with you at All Disciples Sing. We are currently working on the 2026 budget, and we are finding that our expenses are exceeding our income. Several things have been put in to place to reduce the expenses, such as cutting staff time and eliminating expenses like the physical office, copy machine, business phones, internet, etc. But one thing that we have realized is that we have not reached out to the churches for an estimate of giving for several years now.

Our estimate for giving for 2025 was \$70,000 (based off of prior years gifts) and as of 9/30/25 we have received only \$39,678.45.
